

Residential/Commuter Camp FAQs and Packing List

Residential or Commuter?

Residential Campers and Commuter Campers get the same coaching and camp experience. Commuter Campers will check-in at the same time as Residential campers at the dorm. Check-out will be at the same time and at the dorm as well. We are very flexible with pick-up and drop-off times each day as long as the campers check-in and out with the staff. We will provide parents with a tentative schedule at check-in so that they can plan their drop-off/pick-up times.

Location?

All camp sessions will take place on the campus of LSU and at the Tiger Soccer Complex. Residential campers will be housed in the Louisiana State University dormitories with 24-hour adult supervision.

Check-in and Check-out?

Check-In will be at 1pm on the first day of camp. Please eat lunch before check-in so that we can start right into soccer activities. Check-out will be at noon on the last day of camp.

Physical?

We do not require campers to have a physical before attending camp. However, a parent must sign and return the Liability Waiver that will be emailed to you by Tiger Soccer Camp prior to the first day of camp. The waiver is also available under the sign up tab on this site.

Refund policy?

There is a \$100 non-refundable deposit for residential camp if a player is unable to attend camp. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE START OF EACH CAMP.

Roommate policy?

There are only 2-person rooms available at the dorms. Please indicate the person you would like to room with when signing up.

Linens and toiletries?

All campers will need a pillow and bed linens or sleeping bag. You will also need to send toiletries and towels with your camper.

Lost room key?

There is a \$50 fee for a lost room key.

Refrigerators?

There are no refrigerators in the rooms; however there will be snacks and cold beverages, Gatorade and water, available at the Camp Store.

Camp Store?

The camp store will be open daily with snacks and drinks. In addition, some campers may want to order a late night snack. A soccer shop for camp souvenirs will also be available. You can check-out some of the available products under the camp store tab.

Transportation?

We will provide transportation to and from the Baton Rouge Airport. All residential campers who fly into Baton Rouge for camp will be met at BTR and escorted to LSU. Upon completion of the camp, resident campers will be escorted to the airport security gate. You can register for airport shuttle when you register for camp.

Medical Attention?

A certified athletic trainer will be on duty 24-hours a day. The trainer will be staying the dorm along with the staff.

How can I get in touch with my Child at overnight camp?

We prefer campers not to have cell phones because it limits the camper experience. We understand that parents feel more comfortable with their children having a phone. We encourage you to remind them to limit their use of the cell phone. We will provide contact numbers for the staff at the camp and we will allow campers to use our phones to call home at any time no questions asked.
